Communication and facilitation

Dialogue and constructive communication are at all stages of conflict major tools for transformation. This unit looks at different communication patters and proposes methods to improve skills in empathetic listening, respectful assertive speaking, etc. Furthermore a toolbox of facilitation techniques will be developed.

Transforming conflict and nonviolence

Different methods of conflict transformation including conscientisation, nonviolent direct action, negotiation, dealing with prejudice and discrimination as well as working in reconciliation processes will be presented and some of them applied in practical exercises.

Practical mediation skills

From among different roles and functions in conflict transformation, mediation will be focused on this unit. The process of mediation will be introduced and practiced step by step.

Principles, methods and techniques of training

First experiences with training on nonviolent conflict transformation will taken up and developed to look at backgrounds, approaches and design of trainings. The participant will develop their own training programmes for different target groups and practice facilitation of training units in the group.

Development of own trainer profile, and closure

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In this final course unit trainers experiment with and develop own training styles, learn how to adapt contents, methods & instruments to different social and cultural contexts. They discuss and practice intervision techniques and design ongoing learning process for training teams. The course cycle will be formally concluded.

The Training of Trainers will be carried out by an international core team of experienced trainers who will be supported by various ressource persons.

This training course prepares people to work as trainers in nonviolent conflict transformation. For the first time five European training centres offer an international training of trainers with a transcultural approach. The course leads participants to a solid qualification as trainers and enables them to use the new skills for their professional work. The trainees will learn special tools for handling conflicts and crisis situations within communities and groups.

The Program - Objectives

The Training Course "Trainer in Conflict Transformation" will:

- > Raise awareness about and enhance confidence in the possibility of the peaceful transformation of conflict;
- > Assess and enhance existing conflict resolution practices;
- > Create an awareness of a wider spectrum of conflict transformation options;
- > Equip participants with knowledge and basic conflict transformation skills;
- > Enhance trainees' new conflict transformation skills;
- > Empower participants to carry out conflict transformation training in teams and initiate co-operation between participants as a basis for future training work;
- > Identify potential linkages and partnerships for multiplying the training outreach and the impact of the skills development.

Who should apply?

People wanting to become more effectively involved in alleviating or transforming conflicts at the interpersonal, national or international level;

Activists and professtionals working for peace, environmental or human rights organisations;

Teachers and coordinators involved in educational programs, youth programs and social work;

Professionals in community development, human service or religious organisations;

People working with humanitarian projects;

Those who want to work as trainers in nonviolent conflict transformation, either at home or abroad.

The courses are designed for people working in the field at various levels of experience and skills.

Requirements for participation:

Professional training completed;

First experiences as a trainer;

Working knowledge of English; Experience in working with groups and in the field of conflict transformation in social or international settings.

Length of the Training Course:

35 training days at different training locations in Europe (Germany, Slovakia, Romania, Italy and the Netherlands).

Fees for the program:

35 days of training including materials, board and lodging will cost 4.000,- € (for Western European countries) or 1.600,- € (for Eastern European countries). The travel expenses can partly be reimbursed: For participants from Western Europe up to 40% (per travel maximum 100 Euro) and for participants from Eastern Europe up to 100% (per travel maximum 250 Euro). Participants might apply for scholarships from the Grundtvig 3-Programme of the European Union. The organisations involved in this training will assist in applying for scholarships.
